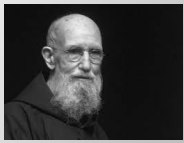

Fr. Solanus' ministry of charity was especially noted during the Great Depression when his concern for the poor inspired the Detroit Capuchins to establish their Soup Kitchen, a service of charity that continues to this day. Fr. Solanus' advice and prayers also aided anxious families whose sons and daughters served in World War II. This longtime Capuchin Detroit friar will be elevated to the status of "blessed," only the second American-born man to be honored with such a distinction.

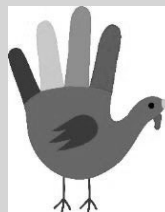
CHRISTMAS AT KOHL HOLIDAY BOUTIQUE
