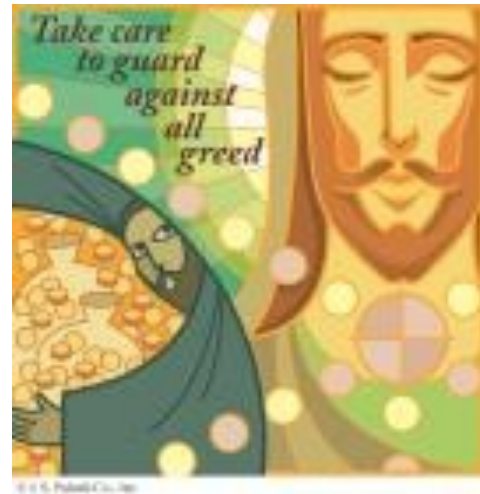

In Colossians, faith in the crucified and resurrected Christ is proclaimed as the path to a richly purposeful and meaningful life. The path of Christian faith places our work, our sufferings, and our limitations within the larger picture of God's purposes for all of us. In Jesus, God is revealed as our companion in human suffering and limitation. God's love is at the center of a meaningful life. We place our trust in this loving God, who created us to share in this love, and to share this love with others.

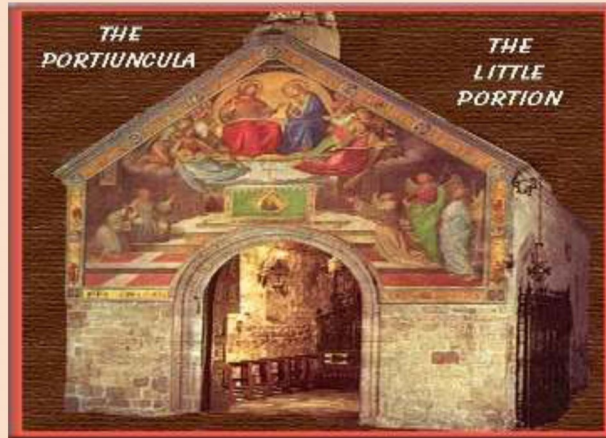
### THE CULTURE PROJECT

*A plenary indulgence may be gained by visiting a parish church or any Franciscan Church. During the visit it is necessary to say the Our Father and the Creed. Also required are Confession, Holy Communion and a prayer for the Pope's intentions.*

*When Christ spoke to St. Francis and told him "go and repair my Church which is falling into ruin," Francis took this literally and began repairing Churches in Assisi. The first church he rebuilt was that of Our Lady of the Angels of the Portiuncula. Francis then made the Portiuncula his home because of his devotion to our Lady. The Portiuncula is a place rich in the memory of the Franciscans and its legacy reaches far and wide throughout the world.*
