Together we can help those out of work, or with limited work hours, seniors, disabled – folks having difficulty making ends meet. Thank you for being the sister or brother, and friend, in the family of God – a beautiful and extraordinary family for which we all aspire.

Food Items Needed

Shelf stable, everyday essentials: fruits and vegetables, breakfast, lunch and snacks, pasta and sauce, protein power. We will have themes each week. Check the bulletin. Use as suggestions, or your choice!

Think simple basics. Canned fruit, meats, and shelf stable entrees go a long way. Those we visit often have limited cooking skills.

Check dates on packaging.

Avoid dented cans or opened packages. Heart healthy (low sodium, low fat) and low/no sugar products for diabetics, are welcome. Please avoid spices and seasonings, extremely hot foods, oil, vinegar, items requiring special cooking skills.
