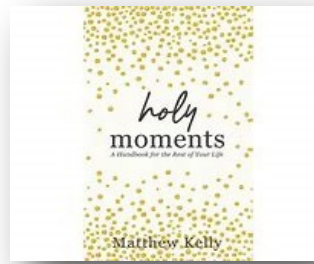

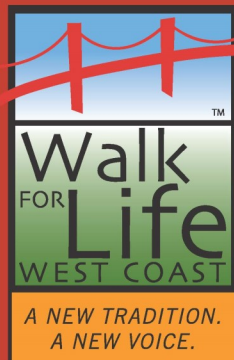

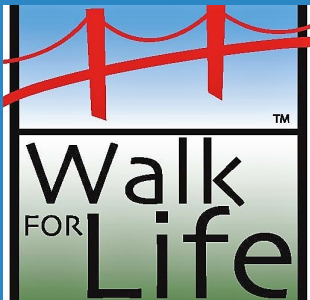
Rally starts at Civic Center Plaza,

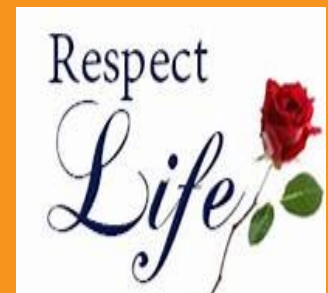
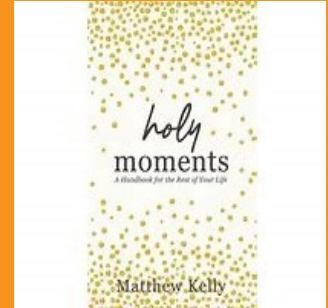
