## DISCIPLES TOGETHER

Today's readings reflect on our communal identity as disciples. Before we begin Lent together in a few days, we take time to appreciate what God has done by giving us our family of faith. In Leviticus, God tells Moses to "speak to the whole Israelite community" and give them instructions for living in love. Moses passes along the message-to each and every believer-that God's people must strive together for holiness. Saint Paul echoes this message, insisting that we are indeed God's holy children. As temples of the Spirit, we belong to Christ and to one another. This mutual belonging is a blessing and a challenge. In Matthew's Gospel, Jesus sets a high bar for Christian community: his followers must love not only those who are easy to love, but also the people who upset us. Together, let us ask God to give us this kind of love.

## Father Greg Boyle, S.J. of Homeboy Industries

## Tuesday, February 28, 2023 St. Matthew Catholic Church At $7: 00 \mathrm{pm}$

Father Greg Boyle is the founder of Homeboy Industries in Los Angeles, the largest gangintervention, rehabilitation, and re-entry program in the world.

He has received the California Peace Prize and been inducted into the California Hall of Fame. In 2014, the White House named Father Boyle a Champion of Change. He received the University of Notre Dame's 2017 Laetare Medal, the oldest honor given to American Catholics.

Father Boyle is the author of the 2010 New York Times-bestseller Tattoos on the Heart: The Power of Boundless Compassion. His 2017 book is the Los Angeles Timesbestseller Barking to the Choir: The Power of Radical Kinship.

## ASH WEDNESDAY

Wednesday, February 22

## LENTEN FAST AND ABSTINENCE

Abstinence: Everyone 14 and older is bound to abstain from meat on ASH WEDNESDAY, the FRIDAYS of Lent, and GOOD FRIDAY.
Fast: Everyone 18 and older but under the age of 60 is also bound to fast on ASH WEDNESDAY and GOOD FRIDAY. On these two days, the law of fast allows only one full meal a day, but does not prohibit taking some food during the day, so long as this does not constitute another full meal. Drinking liquids is permitted. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.
