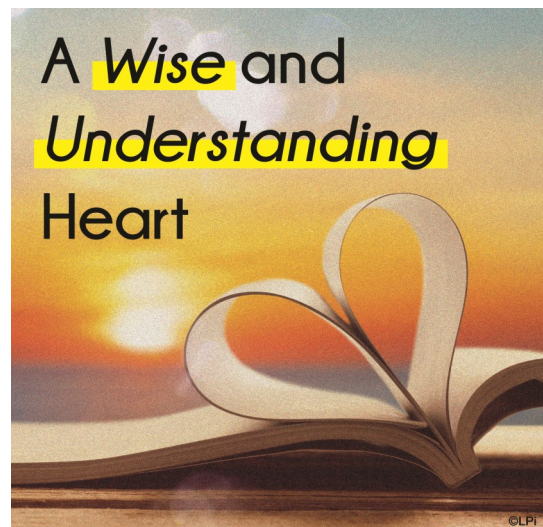

GOSPEL MEDITATION

Our culture seems more polarized and divided than ever. Into this wounded situation, our Catholic faith has a healing remedy to offer: the gift of wisdom. When the Lord offers to give King Solomon anything the monarch desires, he requests “an understanding heart” (1 Kings 3:9). In his polarized situation, the King doesn’t ask for power to defeat his enemies. He asks for a wise and understanding heart to judge right from wrong. This wisdom is elevated and fulfilled in Jesus who teaches us to bring forth “both the new and the old” (Matthew 13:52).

In our fractured society, we Christians should stop pining for political power to crush our perceived enemies. That often just makes things worse. Rather, it’s much more useful to beg for the grace of true wisdom which transcends both sides of the aisle. This places us in a fresh position from which we can help our culture see what is true and good all across the ideological spectrum. Sometimes we’ll look like liberals (e.g., in our love for the poor and marginalized) and other times like conservatives (e.g., in our sexual ethics and views on religious freedom). Because this wisdom is free from ideological narrowness, it will help to heal these painful fractures. Lord Jesus, this week, pour into us your healing wisdom.

FEAST OF OUR LADY OF THE ANGELS
PORTIUNCULA INDULGENCE
(THE PARDON OF ASSISI)



Today is the feast of the "PARDON OF ASSISI," which St. Francis obtained from Pope Honorius III in the year 1216, after having a vision while he was praying in the little church of the Portiuncula. Our Lord Jesus appeared to him in his glory, with the Virgin Mary on his right and surrounded by many Angels.



They asked him to express a wish...

.... and Francis implored a **"FULL AND GENEROUS PARDON"** for all those who would visit that church who **"repented and confessed their sins"**. Having received papal approval, the Saint did not wait for any written document but hastened to Assisi and when he reached the Portiuncula announced the good news: **"FRIENDS, THE LORD WANTS TO HAVE US ALL IN HEAVEN!"**

The Pope granted this petition, and this indulgence has been **EXTENDED TO ALL PARISH CHURCHES THROUGHOUT THE WORLD FOR ONE DAY EACH YEAR**. The date has been set from **NOON ON AUGUST 1 UNTIL MIDNIGHT AUGUST 2**, the feast of Our Lady of the Angels.

THIS IS AN EXTRAORDINARY DEMONSTRATION OF GOD'S MERCY IN REMOVING THE CHAINS OF SIN FROM THOSE WHO DEVOUTLY AND FAITHFULLY SEEK TO GAIN THE INDULGENCE BY COMPLETING ITS REQUIREMENTS.

**CONDITIONS TO OBTAIN THE PLENARY INDULGENCE
OF THE FORGIVENESS OF ASSISI
(FOR ONESELF OR FOR A DEPARTED SOUL)**

- 1) SACRAMENTAL CONFESSION (DURING EIGHT DAYS BEFORE OR AFTER).
- 2) PARTICIPATION IN THE HOLY SACRIFICE OF THE MASS
- 3) RECITATION OF THE APOSTLE'S CREED, OUR FATHER, AND A PRAYER

Congratulations to Fr. Matthew Elshoff, OFM Cap who has been appointed Auxiliary Bishop in the Los Angeles Archdiocese by Pope Francis. Fr. Matt, 67, is a Capuchin Franciscan friar originally from Cincinnati. He studied at the Dominican School of Philosophy and Theology in Berkeley, California, before making his perpetual profession as a Capuchin in 1979 at the age of 23. He was ordained a priest in 1982. Fr. Matt holds a master's degree in marriage and family therapy from the California Family Study Center and received his license in marriage and family therapy in 1990. He spent time as a high school campus minister, vocations director, and novice master before becoming the provincial minister at St. Francis of Assisi Friary in Burlingame in 2008. He is currently the pastor of St. Lawrence of Brindisi Church in Los Angeles. Archbishop Gómez will consecrate him as a bishop on September 26, 2023, at the Cathedral of Our Lady of the Angels in Los Angeles.

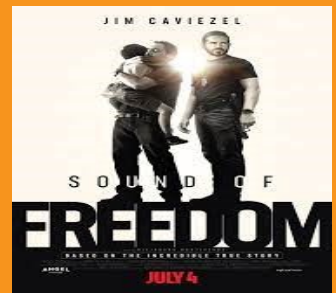

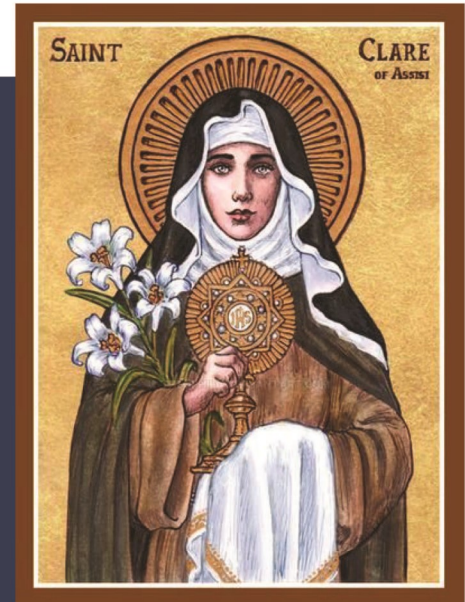
